GENERAL INFORMATION

The BC Championships will take place on date and time as scheduled.

There will be no extension of the Championships past Sunday Nov 3, 2024, due to unforeseen delays or prolonged stoppages. In case of stoppages, priority will be given to "championship" classes. Racing format may also be modified at the discretion of the chief commissaire in response to prolonged stoppages.

Entry fees are non-refundable.

REGISTRATION

Online registration closes Nov 2, 8pm. Late on-site registration will be available. No call up will be considered for on-site entry.

All riders competing in BC Championship categories must have a valid 2024 race license. Championship categories are required to possess, at minimum, a Provincial license. There will be no single event license available for BC Championship categories.

Non-championship, Citizen categories can hold any 2024 Cycling BC license or purchase a single event license on-online.

On Site registration available for cash or e-transfer.

TECHNICAL RULES

The BC CX Championships shall be governed by Cycling BC under UCI rules.

There will be no day of licenses sold for BC Championship categories. All Championship racers must have a valid UCI or Provincial license.

UCI Equipment regulations to be enforced for ALL Championship categories.

Approved helmets are mandatory for training and competition.

Aside from designated pits provided by the organizer, riders may not receive outside mechanical support.

The penalty for any infringement of the preceding will be disqualification.

Race will be held rain, snow, or shine. The race can be cancelled if unsafe weather conditions are present.

DOPING CONTROL

All races are conducted under UCI anti-doping regulations. It is the rider's responsibility to know the rules.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility to compete for the BC championship title/podium/medals, must have a Cycling BC issued UCI license or Provincial license.

All participants must be prepared to present their license during race package pickup.

Race age categories are defined by the rider's age as of December 31, 2025

Out of province and international racers are welcome with international license. If a non-BC resident places in the top 3 within a category, a second podium presentation will be established for the BC residents.

SIGN ON / RESULTS

Sign on tent opens at 7:30am.

Race timing will use RFID number plates. Bring your plate from any LMCX, Spring Series or WTNC. New plates will be available for \$5 cash or e-transfer.

1 Back bib number and 2 shoulder numbers will be issued. Printed stickers, mounted onto paper and pinned on. Bring your own pins and pinnies.

Sign on closes for each category 20min before race start.

Results will be posted following each race. There will be a 30min window to allow for protests.

AWARDS / PODIUMS

Awards ceremonies for each race will be held at the noted times in the schedule.

All podium finishers are expected to attend in proper attire.

Cycling BC will recognize the top 3 BC residents in all Championship categories and award a jersey to the winner.

THRASHERS will award medals to the top 3 in the Citizen categories.

PRE-RIDING

The course will be open at 8am on Nov 3 for pre-riding.

The course will be open for pre-riding between races as the schedule allows. Riders must enter the course only through a gate past finish line. No ducking under tape to enter course at any time.

Pre-riding the course while a race is in progress or at any other unauthorized time is prohibited and will result in disqualification.

Helmets must be always worn when moving on a bike.

CATEGORIES

Age categories are age-based and determined by the rider's age as of December 31st, 2025.

For Championship Categories the rider must enter the category they have declared on their license.

Some Categories will be combined and race together but have separate results and separate podiums.
