All riders MUST sign in and present a UCI licence. Sign in opens at 4:30pm and will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the race. We will accept Team Directors to sign in the team with valid documentation.

Sign in is located behind the Main Stage at Water St and Cambie St. (North Side)



RULES & REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 1. ORGANIZATION

The Global Relay Gastown Grand Prix is organized by Global Relay under the regulations of the International Cycling Union. It is to be held on July 10, 2024.

ARTICLE 2. TYPE OF EVENT

The event is open to athletes of the Men's UCI Elite and U23 categories. The event is entered on the UCI America Tour calendar. No UCI points are awarded.

ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPATION

The event is open to the following teams: UCI Pro Teams, UCI Continental Teams, UCI Cyclo-Cross Professional Teams, National Teams, Regional Teams, or Club Teams. Teams must be formed of a maximum of 6 riders. Individual riders may participate.

ARTICLE 4. RACE HEADQUARTERS

The race headquarters is located at the Global Relay Head Office at 220 Cambie St, Vancouver, BC V6B 2M9.

ARTICLE 5. NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT

Technical support service will be offered during the race. The neutral support is taken care of by a pit setup of mechanics in the left lane prior to the start / finish line. Team managers and mechanics (up to two per team) are allowed entry into this area.

Riders requiring mechanical assistance or because of a crash must report to the pit to get a free lap. There will be no free laps given in the final 5 laps of the race. In the case of a recognised mishap as defined in the provisions governing track races (article 3.2.021), the rider shall be entitled to a neutralisation of one or two laps.

ARTICLE 6. PRIZES

The following prizes are awarded: (see page 10).

A grand total of €17,042.12 EUR will be awarded in prize money at the event. The CAD to EUR exchange rate used will be 1.47, as of June 27. 2024. The prize money awarded will not exceed \$25,000 CAD.

ARTICLE 7. ANTI-DOPING

The UCI and CCES anti-doping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

The anti-doping tests will take place at: Global Relay, 220 Cambie St, Vancouver, BC V6B 2M9.

ARTICLE 8. AWARDS CEREMONY

The following riders must attend the official awards ceremony: The first three riders of the event.

The riders will present themselves at the podium in a time limit of maximum 10 minutes after crossing the finish line.

ARTICLE 9. PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

ARTICLE 10. PULLED RIDER

The rider deemed to be out of contention may be asked to withdraw if deemed out of contention by the officials in the Neutral Service area. All eliminated riders must withdraw from the race immediately upon being called out by the race official on the course. Failure to withdraw will result in disciplinary action.

All other riders shall be classified in accordance with their position.

ARTICLE 11. LAPPED FIELD

If before the last 5 laps, two or more riders should lap the field, the field will sprint for final placing with 3 laps to go. The bell will sound at 4 laps for the group. Lapped riders in the Criterium shall be eliminated upon being passed by the Lead Commissaire and must immediately leave the course.

ARTICLE 12. NUMBER & FRAME CHIP PLACEMENTS

Racers should place chips on the front fork of their bikes. Attach chip with velcro strap or zip-ties. Return both strap and chip to the timing tent before leaving the site. COST = \$75/chip for unreturned chips.



ARTICLE 13. ENVIRONMENT

All staff and riders are to respect the community by not littering along the course. Eliminate all water bottles after the race in designated garbage and recycle stations where appropriate. Team staff should assist in ensuring all team areas are clean when leaving.

ARTICLE 14. CLOSURES

The course will be under full closure from traffic for the entire duration of the event. All pedestrian intersections will be marshaled for access and exit with only emergency vehicles allowed on course.

ARTICLE 15. COMPETITION AMENDMENTS

The commissaires and race organizers reserve the right to make adjustments to the race program as deemed necessary by circumstances on race day.

PRIZE MONEY & PAYMENT PROCEDURES

Prize money for the **Global Relay Gastown Grand Prix** will be delivered immediately after the event at the Global Relay office, 2nd floor. The prize money will be awarded in accordance with the official results delivered to the Lead Accountant who will manage the payment process. The CAD to EUR exchange rate used will be 1.47, as of June 27, 2024.

A 2% UCI tax will be applied to the final payouts.
